Visit the most iconic sites of Yogyakarta. In this trip you will start with exploring the famous Yogyakarta palace and Taman Sari Water Castle, once an enchanting water castle surrounded by Segaran Lake and fragrant flower scent. Next, you will continue to Kotagede area to experience silver workshop. You can bring your own silver as a souvenir to take home. End the day by touring the Malioboro streets with a horse cart.









MERAPI CLASSIC:

JEEP TOUR, and GENERAL ACCESS TO ULLEN SENTALU MUSEUM

Today you will get closer with one of Indonesia's most active volcanoes, Merapi. It is a towering fortress, bordering north of Yogyakarta with Central Java. A sunrise jeep ride is the ideal way to explore, traversing the terrain and taking you to see the bunker and remnants of houses and artifacts from the infamous 2010 eruption. Continue to Ullen Sentalu to learn more stories behind the Yogyakarta's Royal Family. There are ancient artifacts to admire, including some priceless batik, Javanese oil paintings, and local sculptures — all exhibited in a contemporary space surrounded by lush gardens.



Enjoy visit to the Prambanan Temple, built in the 8th century, to showcase how powerful the Hindu Sanjaya Dynasty was during those years. The compound consists of 224 temples, including the three most impressive structures; Brahma in the north, Vishnu in the south, and Shiva in the complex's center. As you explore, your expert guide will share an introduction to the epic tale of Ramayana and decrypt some of the scenes carved on the temple's wall. Finish the day as most others do with Ramayana Ballet Theatre performance.










You will explore the legends of The Southsea Goddes. The legends states that the sultanate was once called Mataram Kingdom, with the first king Panembahan Senopati, beating the previous ruler and claiming his homeland. It is said that he was able to do this with the help of the South Sea Goddess, Which came at cost: all Tomb where the Sultan of Yogyakarta and their royal family have been buried over the centuries that kick off the legends. Afterwards, you will go to Parangkusumo and Parangtritis Beach the beach where the first king was allegedly meeting the Godess. You will enjoy a local dinner in the area.



For an ancient Hindu temple, the main structure of the temples are like no other ancient edifice; it is a truncated pyramid reminiscent of Mayan monuments and surrounded by monoliths and meticulously carved life-sized figures of animals and winged-humans. The temples were the last significant area of temple building in Java before the island's courts were converted to Islam in the 16th century.

We can arrange a helicopter tour to Mt. Ijen and fly over the blue flames of the crater lake before landing directly at Banyuwangi or Bali. This option is ideal for clients who prefer to avoid long transfers to Ijen or Bali.

Note: This program is recommended during the summer months (July - early Oct) due to weather conditions.




# SAFARI AND SUNDOWNER AT AFRICA VAN JAVA












Dubbed "Africa van Java", Baluran is a forest preservation area that covers about 25,000 hectares of the north coast of East Java. In this wide-open grassland space resembling African safari, Baluran hosts numerous endangered species such as the Javan banteng, wild pig, deer, alongside various kind of birds ranging from hornbills to vibrant peacocks.. At sunset, sundowner cocktails and canapés will be served for you to enjoy the golden hour.

On the southeast tip of Java, 1.5 hours drive from Banyuwangi, Alas Purwo National Park is the last un-tamed forests of the island. The park's name means first forest or ancient forest in accordance with a Javanese legend that says the earth first emerged from the ocean here. Here, pure wilderness takes over as we will ride on a jeep adventure to explore the rainforest. First, visit the ancient Hindu temple, Pura Luhur Giri Salaka. Continue to Sadengan, a savanna where in the late afternoon, various animals gather to feed. Among which are Javanese bulls, peacock, deer, monkey and various kind of birds. The journey wraps with sunset on the beach, before returning to Banyuwangi.









IJEN BLUEFIRE AND SUNRISE HIKE

ljen crater is the biggest crater lake in Java. It is here that the famous "Blue Fire" of Ijen can be observed (if not obstructed by the mountain's gas clouds). Seeing it means a midnight hike down to the crater lake, which lies between a natural dams of deeply etched rock. You can also see sulphur miners who climb this treacherous path multiple times a day, collecting the ore up to 90kg on bamboo baskets balanced on their shoulders.









# JEN MARIA 3 MOINN WENT


