Indonesia's landmark destination, Bali is more than a place. It is a mood, a desire, and a tropical state of mind. It is one island, but also many destinations.




BALI SWING, PANGLIPURAN VILLAGE, and THE JUNGLE CLUB








### CURATED ART JOURNEY OF BALI

Additional art workshops such as egg painting, rindik music, wood carving, batik making and Balinese dance is also available on request.




### HERBAL HIGH TEA WORKSHOP






Situated on the slopes of Mt. Agung (Bali's highest mountain), Besakih is the "mother temple" of Bali, equivalent of the Mecca / Vatican for the Balinese Hindu people.

Tour this place with a special touch, where we will take you to Upper Besakih. Situated above the main complex (where most tourists will be), you will be able to learn about the Balinese ancestor lineage, the true significance of the temple, and meet with the spiritual leader in a private guided tour.

Wrap up with a special Balinese village lunch and the stunning frontrow view of Mt. Agung.




Due to its location inside jungle ravine, it is recommended to arrive by 7:30AM for the best sunlight angle and greater chance of less crowds.






The most famous volcano hike in Bali, Mt. Batur is a relatively easy 2 hrs hike. There are many routes to the top and we will tailor based on your preference, short but steep or long but gentler slope. Choose to do sunrise hike (significantly more crowded) or sunset hike.





Significantly less touched by mainstream tourism, Mt. Abang is a moderate difficulty mountain. A generally pleasant 3 hrs trek, with stunning lake and surrounding mountain vista most of the way will take you to the summit, where a small temple resides.









Experience a custom tailored helicopter trip over Bali's major volcanoes. Starting in Ubud, our signature helicopter ride will take you above both Mt. Batur and Mt. Agung; the latter being the highest in Bali with massive volcano crater. Extend this ride further and we can take you to fly above three lakes and Bali's second highest mountain, Batukaru, surrounded by massive rice terrace formations.





Should you wish, you can also visit the base temple, where the instafamous Heaven's gate is located.





In this visit, you will walk around the entire village perimeter, learning the customs and practices of the old times and traversing the traditional architecture of Bali Aga's housing. We take this visit to the next step, where a special workshop made only for you will take place.






Take in the beauty of the East Bali coastline from the water with the signature private snorkeling trips on board Aman XII and Aman XV. Styled after Jukung, a traditional Balinese outrigger, you will set sail from Padangbai Harbour and venture out to a less visited snorkeling site at Amuk Bay, where abundant of corals and marine life awaits.

Experience is available from sunrise (starts at 5:30AM) until afternoon.










### SNORKELING & DIVING AT TULAMBEN



Explore the most popular dive sites on Bali since the wreck of the Liberty, a US Army Transport ship. Located only 25 meters from shore and with the highest point of the ship resting only 5 meters under water, this is a perfect place for snorkeling and wreck diving.

Night dives are also available on request.





The beautiful black sand bay of Amed presents a unique snorkeling and diving heaven. Calm and protected from big waves, this is a place where you can snorkel the entire bay from one end to another, teeming with endless corals, marine life, and several underwater temple structure.

Amed is the easternmost point of Bali. So, make the most of your visit by staying until the late evening to watch one of the most iconic sunset of Bali at Jemeluk Bay.








Towering at 3,031m, Mt. Agung is the highest volcano in Bali. The gruelling 9-11 hours hike can be achieved by a very long dayhike, but we recommend spending 1 night at the mountain.

There are two main routes to take, one which takes you to the crater ridge and the more advance route that will take you to the true summit.

Trekking to Mount Agung requires a much higher level of fitness and mental discipline than any other mountain in Bali and thus is only recommended for experienced hiker.





This is not just a normal cycling activity, rather more to explore the nature and culture in the eastern part of Bali island using the mountain bike.

Explore the largest snakefruit / Salak plantation, and pass through rice fields and interact with the local community It will take about two to three hours to 15km length of the trek. Fresh young coconut will be presented en route.










"The sounds of the forest make the trees here live and die."

With numerous waterfalls available in the region, we have come up with the top 4 for you to choose.


Banyumala is great for those looking to swim at the waterhole, with the falls cascading gently along the rocky slope.

Leke Leke is the smallest among them all, but is situated at a naturally carved grotto which made the scene extremely picturesque.








Embark on a private boat and immerse yourself in the crystal-clear waters as dolphins gracefully swim around you. This trip is available from sunrise until early morning (max departure 8am); where the earlier you go, the better chance you have to encounter dolphins.

Afterwards, you will onwards to visit Brahma Vihara, the largest buddhist temple in Bali. The temple is active and you will meet many people immersing themselves in their religion and their prayers.

Please note that you may choose to remain on boat during dolphin tours if you do not wish to swim with them.





Head out to Bebetin, a traditional village located in North Bali. All activities here are customized according to preference, but they are all focused to immerse you into Balinese culture and daily villager's routine. This includes making offerings and praying, cooking class, market visit, plantation visit (and harvesting if the season is right), and playing kites. Best suited for families, this experience, albeit humble and simple, leaves a lasting memories.

Available as day tour and overnight (note that the village house has very modest amenities and no air conditioner).







CLASSIC:

Visit Dharma Giri Temple, home to a divine huge sleeping Buddha statue. Continue onwards and trek 800m to visit Blahmantung Waterfall. En route, on both sides of the street you can see coffee, coconut and orange plantations.

Finally, wrap the day at the beach in Pemuteran, where you can choose to relax at a beachfront restaurant or watch sunset at a more secluded viewpoint.





The diving and snorkeling at Menjangan is exceptional. The abundance of marine life around this island - which lies within the boundaries of West Bali National Park - is staggering and the corals are bright and colorful. Turtles are fairly common, but so is pygmy seahorse, clownfish, sea fans, parrotfish and many more. With excellent visibility and impressive wall dives, this is one of Bali's premiere underwater spot.



## SNORKELING / DIVING AT MENJANGAN ISLAND





Explore the forest on foot or by mountain bike. Our trained guides will share secrets about the flora and fauna, such as which are the most tuneful birds and which leaf to use for antiseptic. Remember to tread softly to get close to a monitor lizard sunning himself on a rock, or the Menjangan, a unique species of deer for whom the resort is named.

We encourage sunrise walks to give you the best jungle experience and the highest chance to encounter the endangered Bali starling bird.







In this winery tour, you will journey to Seririt / Sanggalangit and visit Bali's wine vineyard.

3 glass of wine tasting and a Balinese Rijstafel lunch is included.

This tour can be resumed with a visit to the wine cellar located in Sanur to experience different wines and fun pairing sessions, and closed with degustation dinner at the private dining room above the cellar.


# IN BALI: BELIMBINGSARI & PALASARI


Follow the story of Dang Hyang Nirartha, a legendary religious figure who traversed the coastline of Bali and is said to be able to heal plagues with just a hair from his head.

In this trip, we will go to the end of the road at Nusa Dua to visit Geger Temple Beach, where depending on the tide, you will be able to follow Balinese cleansing ritual at the beach and enter the small sacred cave of Beji Pemutih, the same place where Dang Hyang meditated.

Continue onwards to Gunung Payung Temple. This barren land was once where Dang Hyang stick his umbrella to the ground to magically create fresh water source.

We will then have lunch break at Melasti area, Bali's southmost beach. Here you will be able to stand at the absolute southernmost point of the island and admire the tall cliffs that made the geography of the area.

Finally, we will wrap the trip with a visit to Uluwatu Temple. On top of the temple tour, we will also show you the statue of Dang Hyang Nirartha himself, bringing an end to his footsteps in Bali.

Facing sunset, Padang Padang is the most accessible beach, while Suluban Beach requires many stairs trekking but has some of the most beautiful view. Thomas Beach is another great option for lounging, albeit requiring some steps down as well.

Facing the open ocean, Green Bowl, Nunggalan and Nyang Nyang Beach all requires significant trekking down the cliff but is all very beautiful, with Green Bowl in particular also hosting a beautiful cave.

Finally, among the numerous cliffs in the region, our favorite remains Jaran Hill, one of the best place to watch sunset in Uluwatu.

Beyond any doubt, Nusa Penida has, hands down, the best Bali's coastal landscape. However, despite being a hidden gem once, it is now one of the most challenging destination to visit. With thousands of daytrippers, our approach to Nusa Penida is to navigate away from the crowd to truly savor its landscape.

We only recommend this destination with the following approach:

1. Overnighting in Nusa Penida. From Bali, private speedboats and yachts departs from Serangan / Benoa Harbour, while public speedboat departs from Sanur. A minimum of 2 nights is recommended for optimum experience, so we can have 2 mornings and 2 sunsets to visit the major sites (before the hoard of crowd arrives)




Journey by helicopter directly from South Bali to the picturesque island of Nusa Penida for an unforgettable trip.

Discover the island's most famous natural attractions and amazing viewpoints on the west / east coast. With this trip, we will take advantage of the helicopter by hovering above the west coast landscape to have a unique viewpoint and staying until sunset, ensuring that you will be able to experience 1 iconic site of your choice without the daytrippers crowd.

The journey will include lunch, all land transfers and excursions on Nusa Penida.







The most famous part of Nusa Penida, in this section you will be abe to explore several sites. First is Banah Cliff, a vantage point with limestone arch. Next is the famous Kelingking Beach, famous for its "Cap de T-Rex" natural formation and the infamous trek down to the beach.

From here, Angel's Bilabong and Broken Beach is another fantastic site to see. This naturally formed hole with suspended rocks creating a natural arch and the naturally formed swimming lagoons are not to be missed. It is also possible to snorkel off the coast here in the morning as they are often frequented by mantas.

Pasih Andus is the next possible site to visit, a rocky outcrop with extremely big waves that would shoot water very high up the sky, creating a smoke-resembling mist (hence the popular name "Smokey Beach"). Finally, Crystal Bay and Gamat Bay consists of black-sand beach and fantastic snorkeling / diving location.

#### Note:

- 1. This area is extremely popular and crowded between 10-4pm with thousands of daytrippers arriving at the same time. We do not recommend visiting West Penida on a daytrip.
- 2. Safety is our priority. In many spots, we will ask you not to go to certain areas just to get a good Instagram shot. Waves around Nusa Penida is not a joke and can, within seconds, become imminent danger.
- 3. Descending and ascending at Kelingking Beach is almost a full day activity in itself. Those wishing to do this will only be able to do so if they are not visiting any other sites in Nusa Penida at that day.
- 4. Snorkeling off Broken Beach and Gamat Bay can only be done with a boat trip and is reserved only for confident swimmer. The water is not calm and sometimes have active currents.

















Our favorite part of the island, East Penida is less frequented compared to the west and has, arguably, a better balance of both nature and culture experince.

Nestled inside the largest cave on Nusa Penida Island, the Goa Giri Putri temple holds great significance for Balinese devotees. The spring water flowing through the temple is believed to be imbued with natural healing properties, making many Hindu people go seeking its curative powers. It has an astounding entrance: an extremely tight and small hole opening up into a massive cave.

Afterwrds, Thousand Island is another site not to be missed. Made famous by the treehouse, this is one of the best place to see numerous limestone formations and steep rocky walls, altogether creating a picturesque view. Walk along the ridge and you will have the option to descend into Diamond Beach or Atuh Beach.











## OUT OF DAYTRIPPER'S REACH:

SOUTH & CENTER NUSA PENIDA

The last remaining section untouched by daytrippers, this region screams adventure and jawdropping views.

Bordered by two very tall cliffs, Tembeling is a region well known for its cool and shaded forest. Entering this area, you will feel very different climate compared to the rest of the island. At the end of the forest walk, a refreshing natural pool and a serene seaside spot awaits, a truly rewarding sight after the trek.

Next, Peguyangan Waterfall is a group of tiny falls and natural pools at the bottom of some cliffs in Nusa Penida, and you reach it by climbing down hundreds of steps on a bright blue stairway. Its steepness, overall height and view makes it one of the craziest hikes in Bali, but the view is completely out of this world. At the bottom of Peguyangan cliff, there's a Hindu temple and a few waterfalls and pools where you can swim and cool off before hiking back to the top.

Finally, at the heart of the island, Pura Puncak Mundi sits at the highest point of the island. Consisting of three complex, explore this mystical temple, which includes the rarely visited Kerangkeng Temple.


Peguyangan Waterfall trek is very arduous and for safety reason, is not recommended for guests weighing above 80kgs. Proper footwear is a must and we will insist that you do not wear flip flops for this trek.












Numerous snorkeling and diving sites are available in the island. Most are concentrated on the west and north side of the island, and this is also where many dive to encounter one of the most elusive diving attraction in Bali, the sunfish / mola mola. We can arrange snorkeling and diving trips in Nusa Penida based on your preference and certification.







20-30 minutes trek away from Crystal Bay, Pandan Beach is a secluded beach where we will setup a barbeque dinner and bonfire. Reserved only for adventurous travelers, this experience will elevate the sensation of being "casted away" in a remote island.

Note: This is a wild experience and although you will be guided throughout the trip you will essentially be walking in the dark on the return trek after dinner. There will be no toilet facility will be available for this trip. Overnight in Penida is required to do this trip and we recommend starting near sunset time to be able to see the wonderful view at the halfway point of the trek. Proper footwear is recommended.








